IMPORTANT INFO TO NOTE:

- Registration for the above sports must be done through SZapp
- Teams will be mixed with boys and girls
- Registrations received after the cut-off, are at the discretion of the Sport Coordinator, in consultation with the Coach
- All of the above activities are guided by the St Joseph's School, Kingswood Extra-curricular sports policy
- All sports teams are coached by volunteer parents. If a team does not have a coach, they cannot be entered into the competition
- All volunteer coaches must have completed the Volunteer process prior to commencing training and games (refer to Volunteers Hub button on SZapp or click this link - <https://sjkingswood.schoolzineplus.com/volunteers-hub>)
- When you register your child, they undertake to complete the entire season- which runs for two terms (Summer term 1 & term 4, Winter term 2 & term 3).
- Students participating in school sport must wear a St Joseph's School, Kingswood uniform. These are loaned from the school, and a \$50 deposit is added to your school fees when your child takes a uniform. The deposit is removed when a laundered uniform is returned at the end of the season.
- All students that represent St Joseph's School, Kingswood for a full season (i.e. two terms) will receive an end of season trophy (at cost to the school – no additional charge for families)
- Teams that would like to continue beyond a season, are welcome to, however will do so at parent expense

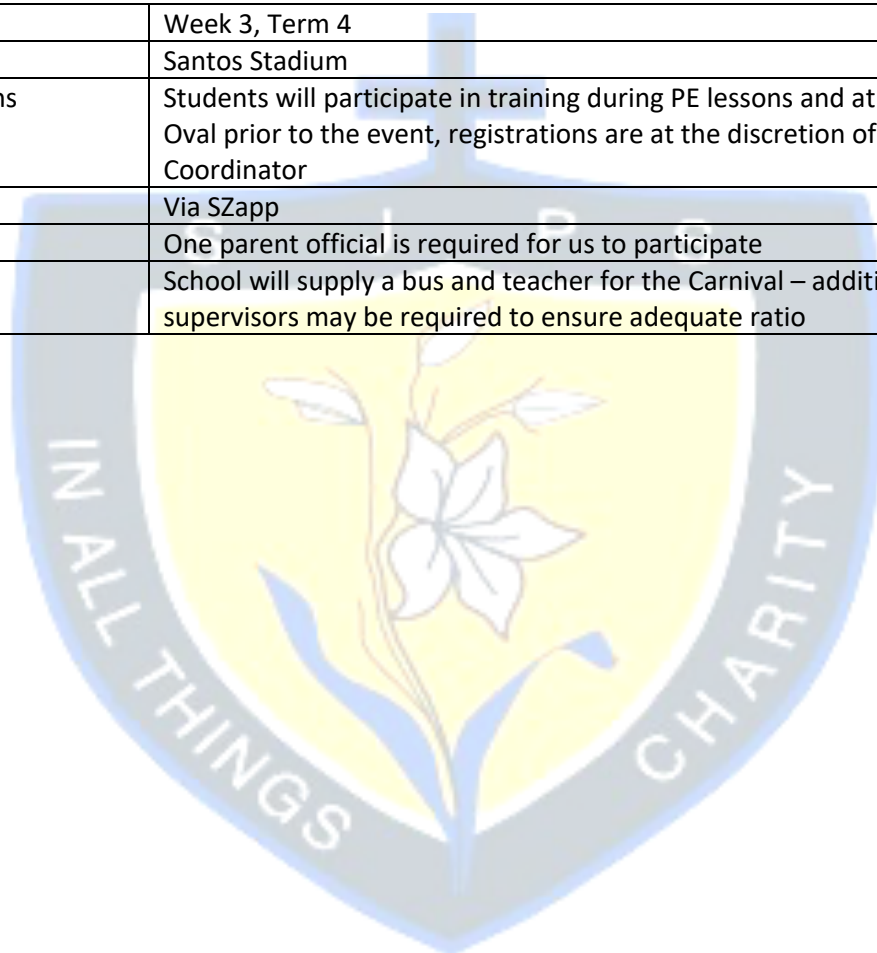
